

## **City of Waukegan 2019 Annual Action Plan CARES Act Amendment**

In response to combating the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Entitlement funds will be used to prevent, prepare for and respond to COVID-19. This allocation was authorized in the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act by President Trump on March 27, 2020 in response to the growing effects of this historic public health crisis.

The City of Waukegan will receive \$470,215 in Community Development Block Grant-Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) funding to allocate to the following activities that address the COVID-19 pandemic related community needs:

### **Public Services**

#### **Funding CV-CDBG: \$176,215**

The CDBG Department will work with agencies to provide resources and essential human services such as rental, utility, food and child care assistance, shelter operations, case management to residents who qualify as low to moderate income and live in the City of Waukegan.

### **Economic Development**

#### **Funding CV-CDBG: \$200,000**

The CDBG Department will work with Waukegan entities that provide direct assistance to income eligible businesses affected by the coronavirus with grants/forgivable loans to help cover eligible business expenses.

### **Program Administration**

#### **Funding CDBG-CV: \$94,000**

The CDBG Department will use the funding for planning, administration, and maintaining compliance of CDBG-CV funded activities.
